## CHAPTER 173.

A Supplement to the act, entitled, an act for the revaluation Panel Mar 13.1833 of Real and Personal Property, in Anne Arundel county, passed at the present session of the General Assembly.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Appoint three col-Maruland.
