Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That individual subscribers for stock in virtue of the provisions of this act shall be entitled to vote for Directors of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company in the same manner as stockholders in the said Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company now

vote, and that the State shall be entitled to have two additional Directors of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company, which Directors shall be appointed in the manner and at the times prescribed by the supplement to this act, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, chapter two hundred and nine, or in such other mode, and at such other times as this General Assembly may hereafter determine.
