Proviso.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That on the application in writing by the proprietors, or if any of the proprietors be minors, by the guardians of such proprietors, of the greater part of the ground necessary to be taken for the purpose, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be, and is hereby authorised to open, extend, and grade, all that part of Vine street in the city of Baltimore, which lies between Cove street and Pine street as laid out under and by virtue of the acts of December session, eighteen hundred and sixteen, chapter two hundred and eighteen, and of December session, eighteen hundred and seventeen, chapter one hundred and forty-eight; *Provided however*, that in all respects except the necessity of having the assent of the proprietors of two-thirds of the property to be taken as aforesaid, the provisions of said acts be complied with and in force as to the said opening, extending and grading of said part of Vine street.
