## CHAPTER 250.

Passed Mar. 10, 1833 *An act to authorize the Justices of the Levy Court, of Somerset county, to allow additional compensation to Joshua Brattan, late Sheriff of said county, for elections held therein.*

Authority to allow addition.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Justices of the Levy Court of Somerset county, be, and they are hereby authorized to allow to Joshua Brattan, late Sheriff of the said county, such additional compensation for elections held therein, during the time of his sheriffalty, as they, in their discretion, shall deem to be just and proper, according to usage in similar cases, and to levy the same upon the assessable property of the said county, to be collected and paid as other public charges are collected and paid.

## CHAPTER 251.

Passed Mar. 16, 1833 *A supplement to the act of eighteen hundred and thirty, chapter one hundred and sixty, entitled, "An act to extend the powers of the Commissioners of the School Fund in Queen Anne's county, and to encourage the establishment of Free Schools in said county.*

Commissioners named.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Arthur E. Sudler, Dr. Jonathan Crane, Daniel C. Hopper, William Grayson, and Rodrick Earickson, be, and they are hereby constituted a board of Commissioners of the school fund for Queen Anne's county; and that all vacancies which shall, from time to time, occur in said board, shall, on notification thereof being given by said board to the orphans' court of said county, be filled by said court, so that, at all times, the said board shall be composed of one commissioner from each election District.

Case of vacancy.

Meeting of Commissioners.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said board of commissioners shall meet in the Town of Centreville, four times a year, viz: on the first Monday in April, the first Monday in July, the first Monday in October, and the first Monday in January; and in like manner annually thereafter, for the purpose of transacting such business as is required of them by this act, and the act to which this is a supplement; and that they receive for each days attendance, as prescribed in
