

- CHAP. 268.** tion, to appoint five disinterested persons, of experience and discretion, who shall be, and they are hereby constituted a board of Commissioners, to open and extend Light street, from its intersection with Hamburg-street, southerly, of the same width and in the same direction it now has north of Hamburg-street, until both sides of it shall intersect the old Ferry road; and any vacancy which shall happen in said board, shall be supplied by a new appointment by the Mayor, and a majority shall be competent to perform all the duties of the board.

- Notice required.** Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners, having given ten days notice in all the daily newspapers of the city of Baltimore, of the time of commencing their operations, shall ascertain and fix the value of the private property required for the aforesaid extension of Light-street, and also of the private property lying west of the west side of such extension, and east of the old Ferry road, and the aggregate valuation shall be provided to be paid to the proprietor or proprietors of such private property; and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, by any ordinances to be passed for carrying this act into effect, shall, in respect of said valuation, provide for an appeal to Baltimore City Court, and a trial by jury in behalf of any person or persons interested in said valuation, and said ordinances shall also provide for carrying the same and the provisions of this act into effect, within two years from and after the passage of this act.

- Value part of Ferry road.** Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners shall ascertain and fix the value of so much of the old Ferry Road as shall be west of the west side of the extension aforesaid, and which will be rendered thereafter unnecessary for a road or street, and which, it is hereby provided, shall be closed up.

- Tender of Road as compensation.** Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners shall tender the part of the old Ferry Road, rendered unnecessary for a road or street, as aforesaid, to the proprietors binding thereon, at the price at which the same shall be so valued in cash, and also that portion of the private property lying west of the proposed extension, as aforesaid, at the rate of its valuation, and if they are accepted and paid for by such proprietors, the commissioners shall execute deeds therefor, conveying to them respectively an estate in fee simple in and to the same.

- Case of non-acceptance.** Sec. 5. *And be it enacted,* That should the proprietors of property binding on the aforesaid part of the old Ferry Road, decline or neglect to accept and pay for the property
