more, in the same manner as provided for in any act or acts to which this act is an additional supplement.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted. That if at any time hereafter can at examination as special or extra session of Congress should be called to the commence at such period as to make it necessary in the opinion of the Governor and Council that the representatives in Congress from this state should be chosen before the time fixed by law for such election, then it shall be the duty of the Governor, by proclamation, published in the distance of the control of the

by law.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That the sheriffs of the sev-shering of earl counties of this state, respectively, under the penalty of fifty dollars, at least three weeks previous to every Vocte penilty, election regulated by this act, shall cause public notice to be given within their respective counties, by advertisements racet up at the most public places within each election discretized that the county, of the time and place of holding the election for members of Congress under this act as well as all other elections as directed in the act to which this is a supplement.

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That so much of the act to Repeal which this is a supplement as may be found inconsistent with this act, shall be and is hereby repealed.
