CHAPTER 314

WHEREAS, by an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty six, chapter one hundred and seventy-two, making appropriations for the benefit of the American Colonization Society; and whereas, by the restrictions of said act, the American Colonization Society have not drawn on the Treasurer for several years past, for the appropriations made by the act aforesaid, for the purpose of carrying into execution the benevolent designs of the state; and whereas, the state having now embarked in that great and important work on her own resources-Therefore,

Section 1.
