CHAPTER 47.

Passed Jan. 31,1823 An act Supplementary to "an act regulating the Inspection of Green Hides and Skins, in the city of Baltimore."

WHEREAS, it appears that the act to which this is a supplement, as engrossed and printed, provides that it shall go
