

49. An act to incorporate the Baltimore Eastern Savings' company.

50. An act to authorise the court of Dorchester county to make valid the sale of certain real estate to Anthony Thompson by commissioners therein named.

51. An act to authorise certain improvements in the eastern part of the city of Baltimore.

52. An act for the relief of Charles Barr, of the city of Baltimore.

53. A supplement to the act, entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one system the laws to direct descents.

54. An act for the completion of a certain trust therein mentioned.

55. A supplement to the act, entitled, an act vesting certain powers in the president of the United States.

56. An act to repeal an act, entitled, an act for the encouragement of an Iron manufacture within this province.

57. An act relating to private wharves, docks, and the like, in the city of Baltimore.

58. An act to explain an act, entitled, an act authorising Cornelia A. Howard, guardian of John E. Howard, of the city of Baltimore, to lease certain property therein mentioned.

59. An act for the relief of Sarah Ann Stansbury of the city of Baltimore.

60. An act to divorce Eliza Selby of Baltimore city, from her husband James Selby.

61. An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to allow additional compensation to John P. Schuyler, and for other purposes.

62. An act for the incorporation of Dorchester Lodge, No. 19, of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows.

63. An act to confirm an act, passed at December session 1831, chapter 232, altering and amending the constitution of this State, so far as relates to election districts in Baltimore county.

64. An act to authorize the commissioners of Washington county, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum or sums of money in cases of epidemics.

65. A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act empowering and directing the commissioners of Cecil county to build two fire proof offices, for the use of the clerks and registers of wills, for the safe keeping of the records appertaining to their respective offices in the town of Elkton.
