239. An act to authorize the Levy court of Dorchester county, to levy a sum of money, for the purpose of building a bridge across Slaughters Creek, in said county.

240. An act supplementary to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the building a bridge over the Patapsco Falls, at or near the Thistle Factory, passed at December session 1831, chapter 27.

241. A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike road from the District of Columbia to the city of Baltimore, passed at December session 1812, chapter 78.

242. An act to divorce Elizabeth Ness, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Samuel Ness.

243. An act to incorporate the contributors to the Somerset Savings Institution, at Princess Anne.

244. An act to provide for the purchase of land and the erection thereof of an Alms House, in allegany county.

245. An additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act to provide for the making of the several Turnpike Roads, and for the extension of the charters of the several Banks therein mentioned, passed at December session 1827, chapter 42.

246. An act to incorporate certain trustees to establish an Academy or School House, in or near Prince Frederick Town, in Calvert County, to be known by the name and style of the Prince Frederick Town Academy.

247. An act to extend the provisions of an act, passed December session 1802, chapter 111, to the Zion Methodist Episcopal Church, in Dorchester county.

248. An act to divorce Albert G. Franciscus, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Eliza I. Franciscus.

249. An act for the incorporation of Concordia Lodge, number seventeen, of the order of Independent Odd Fellows, of the city of Annapolis.

250. An act to authorize the Justices of the Levy Court of Somerset county, to allow additional compensation to Joshua Bratton, late Sheriff of the said county, for elections held therein.
