thereafter, if no sufficient cause be shewn to the contrary, and if confirmed, shall be recorded at the expense of the owner or owners, of said land and materials; and if disputed by either party, the said county court shall determine Court. the same according to law, and the right of the matter; and either of the said parties may demand a trial by jury, on Trial by Jury. issues formed, or leave the cause to be determined by the

court, at their election. Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the President of the Purchase or e United States, or such person or persons as may be appointed by him, shall have power and authority to purchase and contract for all materials necessary in repairing any part of said National Road within the limits of this State, and the same to condemn if refused by the course of pro-

ceedings provided for in the second section of this act. Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That John Hoye, Meshach Commiss Frost, and the superintendant for the time being, appointed report. by the President of the United States, or a majority of them, are hereby appointed Commissioners to report the said National Road, when finished and repaired within the limits of this State, to the Governor and Council of this State.

## CHAPTER 56.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Repeat. That the act passed on the sixth day of June, in the year seventeen hundred and nineteen, entitled, "An act for the encouragement of an Iron Manufacture within this Province," be and the same is hereby repealed and annulled.

## CHAPTER 57.
