ing from the commissioners on account, an oath of the said expenses, including an allowance of two dollars per day, to the commissioners for their services, to levy the same in the proportion before stated on the assessable property of said county, to be collected as other county charges are now collected.

Damages to be assessed.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners by this act appointed, shall value and ascertain the damages that may be sustained by any person or persons, through whose land the said road may be made to pass, taking into consideration the advantages and disadvantages, if any, and the damages so ascertained, shall be levied and assessed as other county charges in said county are, and shall be paid by the county.

Levied and paid.

Case of vacancy, &c. of commissioners.

Sec. 5. *And be enacted*, That in case of the death, resignation or refusal to act of any one of the commissioners hereinbefore named, and from time to time it shall be lawful for those surviving, remaining or qualifying, to appoint another in his stead; and in case of the death, resignation or refusal to act, of any three of the said commissioners, before the making of the appointment last as aforesaid and from time to time it shall be lawful for the commissioners of Cecil county, and they are hereby required to fill up such vacancies at their next meeting which shall take place after such event, or as soon thereafter as may be convenient; all which persons so appointed either by the commissioners named in this act for laying out the said road, or by the commissioners of Cecil county, shall qualify in the manner hereinafter directed.

Oath required.

Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners before they proceed to act, shall take an oath or affirmation before some Justice of the Peace, that they will without favor, partiality or prejudice, assess the damages sustained by the persons through whose land the said road may pass.
