CHAP. 72.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That all the acts, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 72.

*A further additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the distribution of a certain fund, for the purpose of establishing Free Schools in the several Counties therein named, and for other purposes.*

Passed Feb. 19, 1833

WHEREAS, by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, chapter one hundred and thirty-nine, each Election District for Caroline county was constituted and appointed a separate School District for said county, and that the Orphans' Court for said county was intrusted with the funds mentioned in said act for the education of the poor white children in said county, and was directed and required to appoint five Commissioners for each Election District, and that the fund arising to said county, under said law, should be equally divided, and annually placed by said Court, subject to the order of said District Commissioners, and that for the Upper District, there remains a sum unappropriated, and for which reason, in part, is the want of suitable and convenient houses—Therefore,

Preamble.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioners for the Upper School District of the said county, be authorized and required to appropriate, out of the surplus fund now in the hands of the Orphans' Court, such sum of money as, in their judgment and discretion, they shall think proper, (not exceeding one hundred dollars,) to each site or location as laid out and named by the Commissioners appointed by a law passed at the last session of Assembly, chapter two hundred and forty-four, for the purpose of erecting comfortable and suitable houses for schools, and where the same is
