CHAPTER 76.

An act to repeal part of an act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty eight, chapter twenty-one. Passed Feb. 12, 1833

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the seventh section of an act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, chapter twenty-one, be, and the same is, hereby repealed. 7th Sec. repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the clerk to the commissioners for Anne Arundel county, shall be entitled to, and receive as a compensation for his services, such sum annually, as the said commissioners may direct, not exceeding the sum of three hundred dollars, to be levied on the assessable property of said county, collected and paid over as other county charges. Compensation to clerk of commissioners.

CHAPTER 77.

An act to provide for the completion of the records in the office of the Register of Wills of Prince Georges county. Passed Feb. 15, 1833

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Levy Court of Prince Georges county be, and they are hereby authorised and directed, to levy upon the taxable property of said county, such sum or sums of money as may, in the discretion and judgment of the Orphans Court of that county, be considered a fair and just compensation to the Register of Wills thereof, for filing away, making up, and recording such papers and documents in his office, as remained unrecorded at the time of his appointment, and as are by law required to be placed on file and recorded; *Provided,* nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to relieve or invalidate any bond or securityship now existing and responsible for the official performance of the former incumbent, and that the Levy Court of Prince Georges County, if they consider it expedient, shall cause suit to be brought upon such bond, or Levy authorised.
