in the Summe of twenty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to  
be made & Leasid &c. Conditionally that if he should not appear  
at this Court to answer unto what should be objected against him on  
his Lordships behalf and if that in the meantime he should not  
be of good behaviour and now at this Court of S. Emanuel having  
appeared his Recogniz. is Discharged

John Walls & Peter Massey both of Trent County Planters at y<sup>e</sup>  
same Day and before the aforesaid William Comegys & Abraham Rodgrave  
acknowledged themselves indebted unto the Lord prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province  
in the Summe of ten pounds Sterling to be made & Leasid &c. Conditionally  
that if the aforesaid Emanuel Hurst should not appear at this Court to Answer  
unto what should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf  
and if that in the meantime he should not be of good behaviour  
and now at this Court of S. Emanuel having appeared their Recognizances  
& either of them is Discharged
