Conditionally that if he the said Isaac should not make his personal appearance
before the Justices of the then next Court to be hold for the County afo^r at the Court house
in the Town of Chester to answer unto an Judgment found against for felony
and if that in the meantime he should not be of good Behaviour and now at this
Court hold the Sixteenth Day of November Anno Dom 1725 on the hundred and
twenty five the said Isaac Ashley having appeared his Recognizance is discharged
