considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester  
in s<sup>d</sup>. County this thirtieth Day of November Anno Domini Seventeen hundred  
and twenty five that though Sarah Sellwood receive at the publick whipping  
post fifteen Lashes well laid on her bare back all the blood appears and also  
that she the s<sup>d</sup>. Sarah pay the sum of two hundred and eighty pounds of  
Tobacco costs according on the promises aforesaid to the officers of this Court

Ordered that the Sher of Front County carry the s<sup>d</sup>. Sarah Sellwood to the  
publick whipping post and there execute the Lashes in the Judgment aforesaid  
mentioned and then bring her into Court againe upon the s<sup>d</sup>. process the s<sup>d</sup>. Sher  
makes Return to wit the Day and year aforesaid that he hath executed the s<sup>d</sup>. Judg-  
ment and also hath here the s<sup>d</sup>. Sarah Sellwood before the Court

Ordered that the s<sup>d</sup>. Sarah Sellwood pay the sum of four hundred  
pounds of Tob. to Edward Rufens for Maintaining her Child <sup>with</sup> Trouble &  
Disgrace of his Family in bringing her to bed

D. Richard Simmonds comes into Court and offers to pay the sum  
of two hundred & threescore Tobacco for which the s<sup>d</sup>. Sarah promises  
to serve him or his assigns the space of three years from this Court  
also y<sup>t</sup>. s<sup>d</sup>. Richard is to maintain her aforesaid Child during her sojourn
