Robert Brown and Thomas Mafey both of Trent County Plaintiffs At this Court acknowledged themselves indebted unto the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province in the Sum of five pounds Sterling money of Great Britain Easy to be Paid &c. Conditionally that if Mrs. Elizabeth Jones should not make her personal appearance before our s<sup>d</sup> Justices at the Court House in the Town of Chester at any time During Court sitting to Answer to an Judgment for fornication and if that in the meantime she the same Elizabeth should not be of Good Behaviour and now at this Day to wit the fifteenth Day of May Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty five Mrs. Elizabeth Jones having app<sup>d</sup> to the Judgment and Mrs. John Brown and Tho. Mafey their Recognizances and either of them is Discharged

Ordered by the Court here that the Sher<sup>of</sup> of Trent County keep the said Elizabeth Jones in Safe Custody until she shall satisfy both and Charges in y<sup>e</sup> Judgment and amounting to y<sup>e</sup> Sum of three hundred and seventy <sup>two</sup> pounds of Tobacco

Ordered by the Court here that a summons issue for Elizabeth Alford as in &c. to y<sup>e</sup> Grand Jury w<sup>ch</sup> is according y<sup>e</sup> Done
