Thomas Spurrman of Front County aforesaid Plaintiff on the 10th Day of September Anno Domini 1725 before Mr. Marmad. Tildon & Mr. Wm.  keep him thes^d. John Jones in Safe Custody until he shall enter and

 in his proper person doth acknowledge himself indebted unto the
 Right Hon^{or}. the Lord Prop^{ty} of this province of Maryland in the
 Summe of twenty pounds Ster^{ling} money of Great Brittain to be
 made and Levied of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements
 for the use of thes^d. Lord Prop^{ty} of his heirs and Successors Conditionally
 that if thes^d. John Jones shall not make his personal appearance
 before ours^d. Justices at Court house in the Town of Chester in County
