

if the said John Jones should not make his personal appearance before our s^d Justices at the Court House in the Town of Chester in the County of Kent during this Court sitting to answer unto what should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and in the mean time to be of good Behaviour and now at this Day to wit the ~~fourth~~ ^{fifth} Day of April Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and twenty Six the said John Jones having appeared y^e John Austin Esq^r is Discharged

Ordered by the Court here that the said John Jones Enter into Recognizance with good Security for his Appearance and Good Behaviour during this Court sitting and that the Sher of Kent County keep him y^e said John in safe Custody until he shall Enter as aforesaid

The said John Jones being Committed into the Sheriffs Custody for his appearance and Good Behaviour during Court sitting and now at this Day to wit the ~~fourth~~ ^{fifth} Day of April Anno Domini 1726 y^e John having appeared ordered that he be Discharged from s^d Commitment

John Jones of Kent County Jorger at this Court as aforesaid was Committed into the Custody of the Sher of Kent County for his appearance and Good Behaviour during Court sitting and now at this Day to wit the ~~fourth~~ ^{fifth} Day of April Anno Domini 1726 y^e John appearing and no person showing Cause to y^e contrary he is Discharged from his s^d Commitment

M^r John Austin of Kent County Blacksmith comes into Court and offers to pay all the Costward officers fees that hath accrued against y^e John Jones this Court on the premises aforesaid

His Lordship — Simon Edlinor & M^r William Frisby two of the Justices of this Court Thomas Wain Dated Feb^r 24th 1725 to answer unto what should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and now at this Court the s^d Thomas having appeared ordered that his ~~Recognizance~~ Surety Recognizance be Discharged
