 same County on the third Tuesday of June next ensuing to answer
 unto an Judgment for fornication and if that in y^e meantime the
 said Elizabeth shall not be of good Behaviour where-
 with the said Dan^l Dullahunty is Content

To His Lordship Front County sh^h the Jurors for the Right Hon^{ble}
 the Lord prop^{ty} that now is for the Body of
 Thomas Winn - Front County aforesaid upon their Oath do present
 that Thomas Winn of St. Pauls Parish in
 the County aforesaid Labourer the first Day of April Anno Domini Seventeen
 hundred and twenty six at the Parish aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of
 this Court one Pound of the price of Eighteen pence Curr^{nt} money
 of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of certain George Hastings
 then and there being found then and there feloniously did steal
 take & carry away contrary to the peace of the sd. Lord prop^{ty} that
 now is his good Rule and Government and against the form of the
 Act of Assembly in such case made and provided
