That County of Middlesex Memorandum that Touch Francis Gentle Attorney of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} of that shire for the County of Middlesex who for the same Lord Prop^{ty} in this part prosecuteth Doth Com^{er} heron^{er} the Court County Court before Lambert Wilmer Esq^r and his Associates his Lordships Justices of the same County Courts sit at new Town in the County of Middlesex the twenty first Day of June Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred twenty and Six and for the same Lord Prop^{ty} Doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that Katherine Hopkins late of the Parish of St. Dunstons in the County of Middlesex the twenty six Day of March Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred twenty and five at the Parish of St. Dunstons in the County of Middlesex within the Jurisdiction of the Court having been Duely Admonished by the Deputie of the same Parish in the said County did afterward to wit the twenty first Day of April Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred twenty and Six and at divers other times as well before as since the said twenty six Day of March at the Parish of St. Dunstons in the County of Middlesex within the Jurisdiction of the said Court frequent the Company of a certain Walter Trostone of the said Parish and County of Middlesex contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in that behalf made and provided and against the peace of the said Lord Prop^{ty} of that shire is his Good Rule and Government &c. Therefore the same Atty of the said Lord Prop^{ty} for the same Lord Prop^{ty} prayeth the Advice of the Court herein the premises and due proofs of Law in this part to be made against the said Katherine to answer unto the said Lord Prop^{ty} and upon y^e premises &c.
