 Chattells Land, & Tenements Conditionally that if the said Negro Tony should  
 not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the then next Court to be  
 hold for the County on the third Tuesday of March Answer unto what should  
 be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and in the meantime to be  
 of good Behaviour. And the said Negro Tony not appearing at the afo. March  
 Court their Recognizances was continued untill the then next June Court
