Ordered by the Court here that Wm Hagethy of Kent County Gent^l
Enter into Recogniz^{ce} for the s^d Negro Will appearance at next Court to
answer unto what shall be objected against him on this Lordships
behalf and Good Behav^r Thereupon William Hagethy of Kent
County Gent^l Acknowledges himself Indebted unto y^e Right Hon^{ble} the
Lord Prop^r of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of twenty Pounds
Sterl money of Great Brittain to be Levied of his Goods and Chattels
Lands and Tenements for the use of the s^d Lord Prop^r his heirs and
Successors Conditionally that if the s^d Negro Will shall not make
his personal appearance before the Justice of the next Court to be hold
for the County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in s^d County on
the third Sunday of November next ensuing to answer unto what
shall be objected against him on this Lordships behalf and if that
in the mean time the s^d Negro Will shall not be of Good Behaviour
whereunto the s^d Wm Hagethy doth Acknowledge himself to be
