 of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for y<sup>e</sup> use of the said  
 Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup> his heirs and Successors conditionally that if he should not  
 make his personal appearance before the Justice of the Peace next  
 Court to be hold for s<sup>d</sup> County to answer into an Judgment found against  
 him for Adultery and if that in the meantime he should not be of  
 Good Behaviour and now at this Court to wit the Sixteenth Day of  
 August Anno Dom<sup>o</sup> 1726 hundred and twenty six the s<sup>d</sup> John  
 appearing his Recognizance is Discharged
