of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for y<sup>e</sup> use of the said  
Lord prop<sup>ty</sup> his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he shall not  
make his personal appearance before the Justices of the next Court  
to be hold for the County a<sup>d</sup> at the Courthouse in the Town of Chester  
in the same County on the third Tueday of November next ensuing  
to answer into what shall be objected against him on his Lordships  
behalf and if that in the meantime the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas shall not be of good  
Behaviour wherewith the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Jones doth Acknowledge him-  
self to be Content also
