 cannot gain say the Informations aforesaid against him brought nor can  
 he say ~~any thing~~ but that he is guilty of the promises above upon him  
 imposed as by the aforesaid Informations it is alleged & thereupon Submits to  
 the Court Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here below at the Court house  
 in the Town of Chester in sd County the twenty eighth Day of September  
 Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and twenty six that the sd Robert  
 Alexander pay the Sum of two Shillings and Six pence Curr. money of  
 Maryland as a fine for his aforesaid offence of Committing an Assault and  
 Battery in form aforesaid as also that he pay the Sum of one  
 hundred and eighty four pounds of Tobacco for the accruing on the promi-  
 ses aforesaid to the officers of this Court

And now here afterward went the same Day and year aforesaid Robert  
 Alexander into Court and paid y<sup>e</sup> fine in the Judgment aforesaid to the  
 County
