 Court for his appearance and good behaviour during the same Court sitting
 to answer unto an Information found against him for an Assault and Battery
 and his said Recognizance and his Sureties Recognizance being continued
 untill this Court And now the said James appearing Ordered that his Recogn.
 and his Sureties Recognizance be discharged —
