Thomas Jones at last June Court having entered into Recognizance for the said Nathaniel Banks appearance to answer at the then next August Court to an Information found against her for fornication with a Negro and good behaviour which Recognizance was continued from the said August Court until this Court And now at this Court the said Nathaniel appearing Ordered that the said Thomas Jones <sup>his</sup> Recognizance be discharged

Thomas Jones of Kent County Planter at last June Court as a Defendant doth himself Indebted unto y<sup>e</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of ten pounds Sterl to be Levied &c Conditionally that if the said Nathaniel Banks should not make his personal appearance at the then next August Court to answer unto an Information found against her for fornication with a Negro and if that in the meantime she should not be of good Behaviour & which Recognizance was continued until the third Tuesday of Nov<sup>r</sup> then next following at which said third Tuesday of November being the fifteenth Day of y<sup>e</sup> Month Anno Domini 1726 on Sunday & Monday Six the said Nathaniel Banks having appeared the said Thomas Jones his Recognizance is Discharged

Ordered by the Court here that y<sup>e</sup> said Nathaniel Banks Security for to Deliver her unto y<sup>e</sup> County Court or into the Sheriff's Custody after the Expiration of her present Service

The occupiers Peter Massey and Thomas Jones both of Kent County Planters and profert here in Court in their proper persons acknowledge themselves Indebted unto the said Sum of two thousand pounds of Tob<sup>o</sup> each to be made and Levied of their Lands and Tenem<sup>ts</sup> for the use of Kent County Conditionally that if they shall not deliver the said Nathaniel Banks up into the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County (or up to the County Court) at the Expiration of her present Service (she now being ~~now~~ a servant to a certain William Ellis who now
