Doring Thomas Hyson Junr. who being duly elected tryed and sworn  
to say the truth in the premises upon their oath do say that the aforesaid  
Dominick is not guilty of the premises above upon him imposed as by the  
aforesaid Information it is alleged and by John Woodall their foromall  
so say Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court  
house in the Town of Chester in said County this fifteenth Day of November  
Anno Domini seventeen hundred twenty six that the aforesaid Dominick  
to the Information aforesaid he go there of without Day and be therefrom acquitted  
Also it is considered that the said Dominick pay the sum of One thousand  
six hundred and four pounds of Tobacco Cents owing on the premises —
