 unto an Indictment found against him for felony and good behaviour
 And thereupon Thomas Jones of Kent County planter present here in
 Court in his proper person doth acknowledge himself Indebted unto the
 Right Honourable the Lord Prop^y of this Province of Maryland in
 the sum of thirty pounds Ster^d Money of great Britain to be made
 and Levied of his goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements for the
 use of the said Lord Prop^y his heirs and Successors Conditionally
 that if the same Thomas shall not make his personall appearance
 before the Justices of the next ~~next~~ Court to be hold for the County aforesaid
 at the Court house in the Town of Chester in the same County on the third
 Tuesday of March next ensuing to answer unto an Indictment found
 against him for felony and if that in the mean time he shall not be
