Nicholas Neale of Kent County at the Day and Year afo^r before the said William Frisby acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord Prop.^y of this province of Maryland in the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be Seized on his goods and Chattles Lands and Tenem^{ts} Conditionally that if he should not make his personall appearance before the Justices of our then next Court to be held for our said County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in Kent County to answer unto the Complaint of Anne Fennon and if that in the meantime he should not be of good behaviour And now at this Court to wit the fifteenth Day of November Anno Dom seventeen hundred twenty and Six the said Nicholas having appeared his said Recognizance is Discharged

John Rawlinson and William Bearadin both of Kent County Planters before W^m Frisby afo^r acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Lord Prop.^y of this province of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money of great Brittain Each to be Seized on their goods and Chattles Lands and Tenem^{ts} Conditionally that if the said Nicholas Neale should not make his personall appearance at the then next Court to be hold for said County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in the same County to answer
