All the said Arthur Miller on the Day and Year aforesaid before the said George Shroven acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord Prop^r of this Province of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he should not make his personall appearance before the Justices of this Court as a prosecutor for his Lordship against the said Rebecca Jones And now at this Court here to wit the fifteenth Day of November Anno Dom^o seventeen hundred twenty six the said Arthur appearing his said Recognizance is discharged

The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Propriety that now is for the County of Kent and upon their Oath do present that Rebecca Jones late of Saint Pauls parish in the County aforesaid the wife of a certain John Jones the tenth Day of July Anno Dom^o seventeen hundred twenty six with force and Arms at the parish aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court one silver Cup of the Value of five Shillings Current Money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels of a certain Arthur Miller then and there being found then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Prop^r that now is his good Rule and Governm^t and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided
