Mr. George Shurven one of the Justices of this Court Returns a
Recognizance of Henry Culley and John Godfrey for the appearance and
good behaviour of Francis Pool bearing Date the seventh Day of November
Anno dom. seven hundred twenty six And now here at this Court
the said Francis Pool appearing Ordered that the said Henry Culley and
Godfrey their Recognizances ^{and either of them} be discharged

All and Henry Culley and John Godfrey the same Day and Year
as before the said George Shurven acknowledged themselves indebted
unto the Lord Proprietary of this Province of Maryland in the sum of
ten pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain each to be Seized on
their goods and Chattels Lands and Tenem: Conditionally that
that if the said Francis Pool should not make his personal appearance at
this Court to answer unto what should be objected against him on his Oath
behalf on Suspicion of Stealing and Gelding of the proper goods and Chattels
of a certain John Wilson and in the Meantime to be of good behaviour
And now at this Day to wit the fifteenth Day of November Anno dom.
seven hundred twenty six the said Francis Pool having appeared
the said Henry Culley and John Godfrey their Recognizances ^{and either of them} is discharged
also Mr. George Shurven as before mentioned returns a Recogniz-
ance of John Wilson of Kent County and Province Inholder for his appearance
to this Court as a prosecutor for his Lordship against the said Francis Pool
bearing Date the seventh Day of November Anno dom. seven hundred
twenty and six And now here at this Court the said John appearing
Ordered that his Recognizance be discharged

All and John Wilson the Day and Year as before the said George
Shurven acknowledges himself Indebted unto the Lord Proprietary
