 Chas. Smith William Tidmarsh Richard Edes who being duly elected
 tryed and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their oath do say
 that the said Thomas Jones is guilty of y^e felony whereof he stands
 Judged and by Sam^l Dicker their foreman all so say
 Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here with at the Court house in
 the Town of Chester in Shrewsbury this twenty the Day of June Anno
 Domini 1727 hundred and twenty seven that y^e said Thomas Jones
 stand in the pillory for the space of one hour ~~and that~~ and that
 afterwards he receive y^e publick whipping post twenty five lashes
 well laid on his bare back till y^e Blood appears as a punishment for
 his y^e Crime of feloniously Stealing the said Mare according to the
 force form and effect of y^e Ordinance Also it is Considered that the
 said Thomas Jones pay the sume of One thousand & four hundred
 and fifty pounds of Tobacco Costs Accruing on y^e premises aforesaid

Ordered by the Court here at this Day with the Day and year last mentioned
 that the Sher of Shrewsbury take the said Thomas Jones into his Custody
 and Execute the punishment in the Judgement aforesaid specified And after
 wards to bring him into Court again of which I proceed thereto. Proceed with
 John Graham Gent high Sher of Shrewsbury makes the sum on the Day
 and year last said that he hath Executed the said Judgement and also hath
 here the said Thomas Jones before the Court
 Andrew Clements of Cheshire County planter comes in to Court and prours on
 the holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he has attended this Court
 for the space of seven Days as an evidence for his Lordship against
 the said Thomas Jones being then to bound over and returned by the
 Court whereupon it is ordered that y^e said Thomas Jones pay the sume of
 two hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco for his Attendance at
 aforesaid
