a) do into Recognition with good Security for his appearance  
Samuel Hudson since at any time during this Court sitting and good  
Behavior and that the Sheriff of Kent County keep him  
said Samuel Hudson in safe Custody until he shall enter as aforesaid —  
Thereupon Samuel Hudson of Kent County Taylor present before the Court  
in his proper person Doth acknowledge himself indebted unto His Lord  
prop. of this province of Maryland in the sum of £1000 pounds sterl  
money of great Britain to be Levyed off his goods and Chattels Lands and  
Tenements for use of His Lord prop. of his heirs and Successors Conditionally  
that if he shall not make his personal appearance before  
the Justices of this Court sitting time & having that sum  
settled with him in the said time he shall not be of good  
Behavior wherewith the said Samuel Hudson Doth acknowledge  
himself to be content — also  
Samuel Clark and Oliver Palmer both of Kent County Planters and  
present before the Court in their proper persons do acknowledge themselves  
indebted unto the Lord prop. of this province of Maryland in the sum of  
five pounds sterl money of great Britain each to be Levyed off their  
goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for use of His Lord prop. of  
his heirs and Successors Conditionally that though Samuel Hudson  
shall not make his personal appearance before the Justices of this  
Court at any time during the same now sitting and in the next time  
he shall not be of good Behavior wherewith the said Samuel Clark and  
Oliver Palmer are content —

Ordered by the Court that of the Sheriff of Kent County put Mr. Young in the  
stocks for a space of quarter of an hour for his Misdemeanor in open Court  
The Court adjourn till to Morrow Morning at eight of the Clock —
