John Greenwood Sen. of Kent County planter at the same Day of July Anno Domini 1724 before the same William Comneys acknowledged himself indebted unto the said Lord Prop^{ty} in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money to be Levied &c. Conditionally that if Henry Spencer should not make his personal appearance at this Court to answer as aforesaid Whereupon for that the said Henry having appeared the said Johns Recognizance is Discharged —

Lidia Chick of Kent County Spinster at the same Day of July Anno Domini 1724 before the same William Comneys acknowledged herself indebted unto the said Lord Prop^{ty} in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money to be Levied &c. Conditionally that if she should not make her personal appearance at this Court as an Evidence against the said Henry Spencer and now at this Court the said Lidia appears and thereupon her s^d Recognizance is Discharged —

John Brisco of Kent County planter at the same Day of July Anno Domini 1724 before the same William Comneys acknowledged himself indebted unto the said Lord Prop^{ty} in the sum of five pounds Sterling money to be Levied &c. Conditionally that if Lidia Chick should not make her personal appearance at this Court as an Evidence ag^t the said Henry Spencer and now at this Court the s^d Lidia appears and thereupon y^s John Brisco's Recognizance is Discharged —

Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Henry Spencer enter into Recognizance with good security for his appearance at next Court to answer unto what shall be objected against him the same Henry on his said Lordships behalf on suspicion of killing a certain hog on Sunday the nineteenth of July last and be of good behaviour Thereupon Henry Spencer of Kent County planter present —
