 in the premises and Disposal of Law in this part to be made against
 the said Daniel to answer into the said Lord Prop. of and upon the
 premises &c.

 hath here ready twelve &c. as by his receipt he was Commanded and
 now here afterwards to wit the Day and year last mentioned Cause
 against the said Lord Prop. by Touch Francis his Clerk of Auditors and
