These facts is considered by the justices here this twenty second Day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty seven that the said Daniel Spearline pay the Sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco as a fine for his aforesaid offence of committing an assault according to the force form and effect of the verdict and to be applied according to Act of Assembly in that behalf made and provided also it is considered that the said Daniel pay the Sum of Seven hundred and twenty eight pounds of Tobacco Costs accruing on the promises aforesaid of officers of this Court
