Wm. Nevill having appeared through George Hanson and Wm. Wattham their Kny and either of them is Discharged

This Lordship - Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Williams Nevill enter into Recognizance with Good Security for his appearance before the Court to Answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and Good Behaviour Thereupon William Nevill of the said County Planter and present here in Court in his proper person Acknowledges himself Indebted unto the Lord Prop. of this Province of Maryland in the Sums of twenty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be levied of his Goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements for y. use of the said Lord Prop. of his his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he shall not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the next Court to be hold for the County aforesaid at the Courthouse in the Town of Chester in y. said County on the third Tuesday of November next ensuing to Answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and if that in the mean time he shall not be of Good Behaviour where with the aforesaid Wm. Nevill doth Acknowledge himself to be Content also James Dyatt and John Nevill both of the said County Planters and present here in
