Yesterday Minutes Read and approved

This Lordship sheweth Com^{rs} of the Peace for the Right Honourable
 Lord Alford } the Lord Prop^r of the said County of York that now is for the Body of Kent
 of St. Pauls Parish in the County of Lancaster the tenth Day of July
 Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred and twenty seven at the parish afo^{re}
 in the County afo^{re} within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a
 certain M^o Johnson in the Peace of God and of the s^o Lord Prop^r
 then and there being with force and Arms an Assault Did make and
 her the said M^o Johnson and there Did Beat wound and Cillytreat so
 that of her life it was much Dispaired and other Leases to her
 then and there Did to the great Damage of s^o M^o Johnson and Contrary
 to the Peace of s^o Lord Prop^r of that now is his M^o and Govern^r
 &c. Francis Lord Prop^r

To sh^o M^o Johnson - In the Back of s^o proceeding Judgment
 was as fol^o viz^t A True Bill by Will^m Kinggold foreman
 And the afo^{re} Lord Alford in his proper person Comes and saith that he is
 in no sort Guilty of the promises above upon him imposed as by the
 afo^{re} Judgment it is alledged and there of he putteth him self upon
 the Country - Lord Alford in s^o Offer

And he who followeth for the Lord Prop^r of saith that he is Guilty
 Francis of Lord Prop^r
 And now Lord afterwards to wit the Day and year afo^{re} Comes the afo^{re}
 Lord Alford in his proper person and Relinquishes the plea afo^{re} and
 saith that he cannot gainsay the Judgment afo^{re} as afo^{re} against him
 brought nor Can he say but that he is guilty of the promises above
 upon him imposed as by the afo^{re} Judgment it is alledged & there upon
 Submits to the Court Therefore it is Considered by the Justices
 here
