Whereupon John Wilson of Kent County Taylor at August Court Last being the day and year aforesaid acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord Property of this Province of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to be made and Seized of his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the aforesaid Mary Wilson shall not make her personal appearance at the next November Court to answer unto the Indictment aforesaid as aforesaid with the aforesaid Mary Spearman and in the mean time she be of good Behaviour — And now at this Court here to wit the twenty first Day of November Anno Domini 1797 the said Mary Wilson personally cometh and appeareth to the Recognizance aforesaid — also

Katharine Bullock at August Court Last as aforesaid was ordered to find Security for her appearance to this Court as an evidence against the aforesaid Mary Spearman & Mary Wilson —

Whereupon Bowles Green of Kent County Planter at August Court Last being the day and year aforesaid acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord Property of this Province of Maryland in the sum of five pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to be made and Seized of his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the aforesaid Katharine Bullock shall not make her personal appearance at the next November Court as an evidence against the aforesaid Mary Spearman and Mary Wilson And now at this Court here to wit the twenty first Day of November in the year aforesaid last mentioned the said Katharine Bullock having appeared the said Bowles Green his Recognizance is discharged —
