Now at this Court here to wit this twenty first day of November Anno Dom seven teen hundred twenty and Seven the sd Mary Wilson cometh and appeareth to the Hon^{rs}: = nized of —

That County J^s. The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of West County and upon their oath do present that Mary Wilson Late of Saint Pauls Parish in the County and the wife of John Wilson of the same Parish and County Freeholder the tenth day of July Anno Dom seven teen hundred twenty and Seven with force and arms at the parish and in the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court two Geese of the value of Eighteen pounds of Tobacco each and one Gender of the value of Eighteen pounds of Tobacco and of the goods and Chattels of a certain person to the Jurors and unknown then and there being found then and there feloniously did steal take and carry away Contrary to the Peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided & — Francis Clerk

On the back of the proceeding Indictment was endorsed as fold viz^t

And the sd Mary Wilson in her proper person comes and saith that she is in no sort guilty of the premises above upon her imposed by the sd Indictment it is alledged and thereof she putteth her self upon the Country — Mary Wilson J^{ss} Jones

And the sd Tench Francis attorney of the said Lord Propriety cometh and saith that forasmuch as he hath not evidence sufficient to Maintain the sd Charge in the Indictment and specified against the said Mary Wilson he will not prosecute the same Indictment any further Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in West County this
