Thereupon John Wilson of Kent County Taylor at August Court last being the Day and Year aforesaid acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Right Hon. the Lord Proprietor of this Province of Maryland in the sum of five pounds Sterling Money of Great Brittain to be made and Levied of his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Mary Sparman shall not make her personall appearance at the then next November Court to answer unto an Indictment found against her for stealing seven Dunghill fowles and if that in the mean time she should not be of good behaviour wherewith the same John is Content —

And now at this Court held to wit this twenty first Day of November Anno Domini seventeen hundred twenty and seven the said Mary Sparman having appeared the said John Wilson his Recognizance is discharged —
