Also it is Considered that the said Thomas Stacey pay the sum of four hundred seventy one pounds of Tobacco Costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the Officers of this Court —

Ordered by the Court here at this Day to wit the Day and Year Last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Thomas Stacey into his Custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and afterwards to bring him into Court again —

Of which process the said Sheriff to wit John Gresham Gent High Sheriff of Kent County makes return on the Day and Year last said that he hath executed the said Judgment and also hath here the said Thomas Stacey before the Court —

Ordered by the Court here that the Sheriff of Kent County keep him the said Thomas Stacey in safe Custody until he shall satisfy the four fold and the sum of four hundred seventy one pounds of Tobacco Costs in the Judgment aforesaid —

So now here afterwards to wit the Day and Year aforesaid Comes into Court the said William Bradshaw Prosecutor for his Lordship and Relinquisheth the four fold aforesaid and thereupon the said Thomas Stacey is therefrom acquitted —

Edward Coufers of Kent County Weaver comes into Court & proves on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he hath attended this Court as an Auditor for his Lordship against the said Thomas Stacey for the space of two days being thereto Lawfully Summoned Whereupon the said Thomas Stacey is ordered to pay to the said Edward Coufers the sum of Sixty pounds of Tobacco for his attendance as aforesaid according to Act of Assembly in such Cases lately made and provided —
