William Burk at August Court last as aforesaid acknowledged himself Indebted unto the aforesaid Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Britain to be made and Seized of his goods and Chattles Lands & Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he should not make his personall appearance at the then next November Court as an evidence against the aforesaid William Wood And now at this Court here to wit the twenty first Day of November Anno Dom 1727 hundred twenty and seven the aforesaid William Burk having appeared his Prognizance is Discharged. ————— also
