Act of Assembly in that Case made and provided and against the
peace of the said Lord Prop^r his good rule and Dignity wherefore
the aforesaid atty prayeth the Advice of the Court here in the premises
for the said Lord Prop^r and due proofs of Law against the aforesaid
A Seeger Code in this part to issue to enquire to the aforesaid
Prop^r of and upon the Premises &c.

The aforesaid A Seeger Code producing a Noli prosequi from his Excell^{ty}
whereupon the Court orders all proceedings to cease and the Noli
prosequi to be entered which is as follows viz:

To the Worshipfull Justices of Kent County —
Whereas I am Informed by Col^l A Seeger Code of y^r County that
he is apprehensive there may be a prosecution against him in
your County Court for incontinently living with a certain
Jane Honnerd and whereas I am given to understand that the
prosecution is contrived and carried on by a troublesome woman
more out of prejudice and Malice to him than any regard to
the Law, and altho the said Persons may be able to acquit themselves
of the accusation, yet there will be a Charge I do therefore hereby
Order you that immediately upon Return of a presentment or
Information or any other means of prosecution for that fact
against the above said persons or either of them that you stop
any further proceedings therein and Enter a Noli prosequi thereon
for all which this shall be your Warrant Given under my
hand
