Memorandum that John Francis Gent Attorney of the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary that now is for the County and who for the same Lord Proprietary in his part prosecuteth both come here into Trent County Court before Lambert Wilmer Esq: and his associates his Lordships Justices of the same County Court to wit at Chester Town in the said County the fifteenth Day of August Anno Domini 1727 on the hundred twenty and seven and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that Jane Kennard late of Saint Pauls parish in the County and the wife of a certain Nathaniel Howard of the same parish and County the the twenty fourth day of June Anno Dom 1727 on the hundred twenty and seven at the parish and in the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court having been duly admonished by the Vestrymen of the same parish in the said County did afterwards to wit the twenty ninth day of June Anno Dom 1727 on the hundred twenty and seven and at divers other times as well before as since the said twenty fourth day of June at the parish and in the County and within the said Jurisdiction (the said Nathaniel Howard and yet being the lawful husband of the said Jane) did adulterously frequent the company of a certain Negro Girl of the said parish and County contrary to the Act of Assembly in that
