Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to sit at the Court house in the town of Chester in said County this nineteenth day of March anno Domini Seven hundred & twenty seven that the said Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is do recover against the afo Mary Wilson the sum of two hundred pounds of tobacco as a fine for her offense afo in form afo Constat according to the force form and effect in the law in such case made and provided & also it is considered that the said Mary Wilson pay the sum of three hundred eighty & six pounds of tobacco abiding on the offense afo to the officers of this Court &c
