And the said Mary Buryman in her Answer upon Oath saith
 that she cannot gain say the Judgment aforesaid against her brought
 nor but that she is guilty of the Offence above upon her imposed
 by the said Indictment it is allowed & thereupon submits to the
 Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at the
 Court house in the town of Chichester in said County on the
 Day of March Anno Domini 1727 that the said Mary Buryman
 received at the Publick whipping Post fifteen Lashes well laid on
 her bare back until the blood appeared as a Punishment for her
 said Crime of committing fornication in form aforesaid also it is
 considered that she pay the Sum of three hundred & five pounds of
 Tobacco Costs Accruing on the Offence aforesaid to the Officers of this Court
 It is also ordered by the Court here at this Day to wit the Day aforesaid
 and that the Sheriff of W. County take her the said Mary into his Custody
 to execute the Punishment in the Judgment aforesaid & afterward
 to bring her into Court again of W. County the Sheriff to wit John
 Grosham Gent. Sheriff of W. County makes Return thereof On
